Why Las Hurdes?

The person who has ever heard of Hurdes, have listened the sad story and the black legend that once had the area. However, only a few travelers know how the region is, the natural paradise in which those Hurdanos have lived for centuries suffering

a terrible isolation by its topography and being forgotten by the rest of the country..

And which caused a lack of communication and isolation in other times, today has become a real tourist attraction. In fact, the natural beauty of Las Hurdes is such that it is not difficult to feel overwhelmed by their vertical landscapes from the highlands or impressed by their collected corners, waterfalls or rivers of clean water, whose courses twist in unlikely meanders. And all this while we are seeing black storks or vultures, otters and deer.

We must remember that almost all the region is protected as an SPA (Special Protection Area for birds) and SCI (Site of Community Interest), figures that recognize and protect its biodiversity and the species that inhabit the region. It also has areas of scientific interest and several cataloged trees.

Waiting for the traveller there are some "alquerias" of traditional slate houses, as well as some ethnographic centers which preserve the historical memory in their houses and in its labyrinthine urban tracings. For mentioning one of these singular spaces, the Valley of the Malvellido, El Gasco, Fragosa ...

No less interesting is the proximity of towns of great historical and artistic value, even some protected biodiversity areas, such La Alberca, a very beautiful and little town of Salamanca, or Granadilla, an historical village of Cáceres that lies over the Gabriel y Galán reservoir, or the Natural Park of Las Batuecas, of Salamanca too.
